## International piano master class

### Heidrun Holtmann

Born in Münster, Heidrun Holtmann began to take piano lessons at the age of four. At the age of nine, she joined the piano class of Prof. Renate Kretschmar-Fischer at Detmold musical college, where she passed her artistic maturity examination "summa cum laude" and her final examination "with distinction".

Heidrun Holtmann won several prizes in national and international contests.

Within a few years after she had won first prize at the Zurich "Concours Géza Anda" in 1982, she had won over critics and audiences alike. Subsequently she played under directors like Antal Dorati, Ivan Fischer, and David Zinman with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, London, the Detroit Symphony Orchestra, and the Tonhalle Orchestra of Zurich as well as with numerous other symphony and chamber orchestras in the Federal Republic of Germany and abroad.

Heidrun Holtmann is a regular guest at international festivals, including Salzburg, Paris, Barcelona, Brescia/Bergamo, Stresa, Luzern, Berlin, the Ruhr Piano Festival, the NDR Musical Summer, and the Athens Piano Festival as well as the chamber-music festivals at Lockenhaus, Kuhmo, Prussia Cove, and St. Moritz. She has toured all over Europe, Japan, Taiwan, South and Southeast Asia, the USA, Canada, and South America.

Eminent European broadcasting corporations work with her frequently. Thus, for example, NDR Fernsehen portrayed her for the ARD and engaged her for a television concert (Chopin's piano concert in E minor with the NDR Symphony Orchestra directed by Klauspeter Seibel). For RTSI-TV as well as for sale on DVD, she recorded two early piano concerts by Mozart with the Orchestra della Svizzera Italiana directed by Marc Andreae.

Her discography includes a complete recording of all works for piano and orchestra by Robert Schumann (Radio Symphony Orchestra Berlin under Stefan Soltesz) as well as several solo CDs that span a wide repertoire ranging from Bach, Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, Schumann, Chopin, Debussy, and Skryabin to Martin and Holliger. Most recently, she has published a twin CD featuring nocturnos by composers of the 19th and 20th century.

Heidrun Holtmann has been teaching master classes at various festivals, including the "Kuhmo Chamber Music Festival" and the "Art Link Festival Belgrade".
